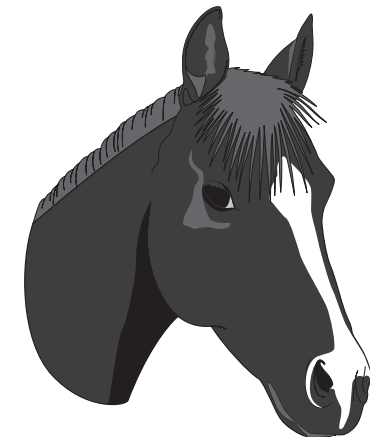

Meghan Cunningham is in her 4th year as head coach. Under her leadership, the hunter seat discipline has made 2 appearances at the Varsity Equestrian National Championships, seeded 9th and 11th respectively. Prior to joining the skyhawk family, Cunningham was an assistant coach at Kansas State University for four years. While at Kansas State, Cunningham led the hunt-seat squad to three regional championships (2003-2005), one zone championship (2003) and two national appearances (2003, 2005). During 2005, the hunt-seat squad placed sixth at Varsity Championships and seventh at IHSA Nationals. With 11 individual riders qualifying for national competition, including three high-point riders for competition in the Cacchione Cup.

Brenna Burris enters her third season as the team's assistant coach. Burris comes to Tennessee-Martin from Baylor University where she majored in education. During her college career she has served as a team president, team leader, year end MVP, team campaign and a fifth year student athlete. Burris has shown Appaloosas throughout her life earning several year end high point awards, 3 Canadian National Championships and 2 Reserve National championships. She has gained experience working for several top trainers through the years.

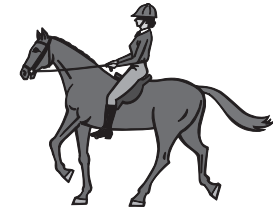
Camp Cost
