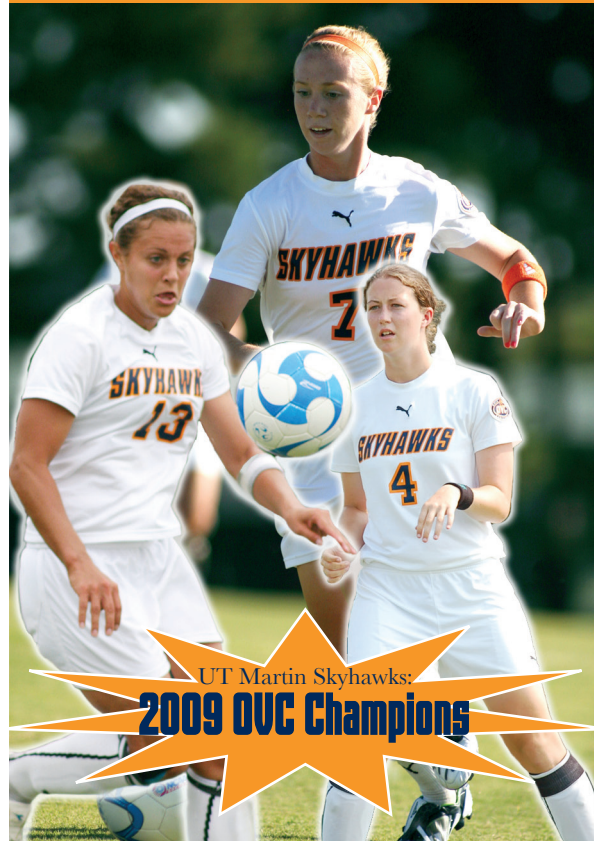

Elite Feet Residential Team Camp

The residential team camp offers a unique learning experience in a residential setting. The sessions focus on specific requests from the team coach and/or will allow our highly experienced staff to enhance both the technical and tactical application of your team. The technical and tactical aspects of the game will be thoroughly covered to give players a perspective of what is required to play at the collegiate level. Team bonding and communication will be emphasized in preparation for the upcoming season. In addition there will be instruction on speed, strength, psychological, and nutritional components. Night sessions will consist of fun elements such as beach and "soca" soccer. Emphasis will be placed on developing the complete soccer player and exposing them to the collegiate level. Teams must consist of a minimum of 12 players. A camp soccer ball is included with registration. Meals will be provided for campers.

Elite Feet Residential Camp

The residential camp offers a unique and comprehensive learning experience for both male and female players and goalkeepers. Sessions focus on the technical and tactical aspects of the game. The sessions will provide the athletes with instruction from high-level coaches who will help prepare them for the next level. A camp soccer ball is included with registration and meals will be provided.

Elite Feet Day Camp

This camp is for ages 8-18. The day camp will focus on advanced technical and tactical application. Players will be provided with the tools necessary to improve speed, strength, psychological and nutritional components. Emphasis will be placed on developing the complete soccer player and preparing them for the next level. Bring your own lunch. Lunch will NOT be provided.

Elite Feet Minikicker Camp (Ages 5-7)

Tuition will focus on an introduction to soccer fundamentals. Games and activities will be used to enhance the cognitive, social, and psychological tools needed in future years. The emphasis will be on creativity, team spirit, and a fun atmosphere!

Elite Feet Goalkeeper Camp

For young keepers, it may be their first formal introduction to serious goalkeeping. For advanced goalkeepers, it will be a comprehensive review of goalkeeping within a competitive training atmosphere. Students will be placed in an introductory or advanced group. Students will explore all dimensions of goalkeeping and will be instructed on what it takes to play at the next level. Goalkeepers will also be given the opportunity to develop their skills in a competitive environment with quality field players. Goalkeepers may participate in residential academy for \$365.

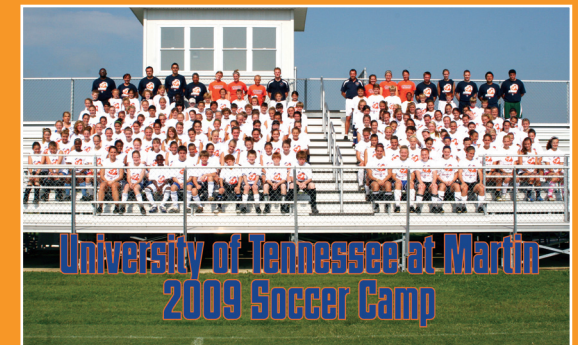

Craig Roberts, Camp Director



Roberts has over 18 years of national and international soccer coaching and playing experience, including both men's and women's NCAA Division I and NAIA. He has had professional experience and exposure to the Olympic Development Program in three states. In addition, he currently holds a USSF A License, NCSAA Goalkeeping License, and English FA Premier Coaching License.

At UT Martin, Roberts has transformed the Skyhawks into a perennial powerhouse in the Ohio Valley Conference. In Roberts' four years, the Skyhawks have tied or broken 34 school records – winning 29 matches over the last three seasons. After taking the head coaching job just four weeks prior to the beginning of the 2006 season, Roberts guided UT Martin to its first OVC Tournament appearance in three years. The next season, the Skyhawks set a program record for wins (10) and were ranked by Somis Sports as the 16th most improved team in all of NCAA Division-I. UT Martin won its first OVC Tournament match that year, setting the stage for two of the most historic seasons in Skyhawk history.

In 2008, the Skyhawks advanced all the way to the OVC Tournament Championship, once again tying the program mark for wins with 10. UT Martin broke or tied 13 school records and had six different players recognized by the OVC. Last season, Roberts led the Skyhawks to its first OVC regular-season championship, winning six of its last seven matches to end the regular season. UT Martin relied on a tight defense, as they ranked as high as No. 20 in the NCAA in Goals Against Average during the season.

Roberts has coached the program's only OVC Defensive Player of the Year, and the only two players to be recognized as All-OVC first team honorees twice in a career. All in all, Roberts has guided 21 All-OVC players, and 16 of the program's 25 OVC Players of the Week, which includes four consecutive mentions during the 2008 season. Roberts' players have also earned their fair share of national recognition, as the Skyhawks had the Soccer Buzz National Elite Player of the Week in 2006. Most importantly, however, the Skyhawks have flourished in the classroom under Roberts, as he has placed 41 players on the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll in three years, including an OVC Scholar-Athlete Award winner in 2008 – which is the highest individual accolade any OVC student-athlete can achieve.

Coaching Staff

The UT Martin Elite Feet Soccer Camp staff will be an all-star collection of the nation's top collegiate, club, and scholastic coaches who will help develop the skills and know-how of the next generation of soccer stars. Enhancing the learning experience will be demonstrations of skill and ability by UT Martin players who are among the best in the country. On and off the field, the UT Martin Elite Feet Soccer Camp offers the best supervision for participants. Certified athletic trainers are on duty throughout the course of the camp and will be available for immediate care.
