## Doug Milholland Reining Clinic

On February 28th at 8:00 am, the clinic will start. Individual and group instruction will be given and tailored to meet the needs of the participants. Maneuvers will be grouped together and divided across the day. For instance, circle, spins, and lead changes may be in the morning and stops and rollbacks in the afternoon.

## Eligibility

**T**hose participating on horseback should be capable of walking, jogging, loping in each lead correctly, turning on the haunches, control through both upward and downward transitions, and overall control in a group riding environment. Open to auditors of all ages and backgrounds. Come join us for an entertaining and educational event and learn more about the sport of reining.

\*University policy requires all horses to have current coggins and health papers.

## Clinic Cost

The cost of the clinic will be \$400 for riding participants and for auditors \$25 and \$30 (at door) per day. Also lunch will be provided for all individuals which pay full clinic fee. Clinic fee covers one horse stall. Additional horse stalls are available at \$20 and bedding is included in the fee. A concession stand will be open. Due to limited space, a 100% nonrefundable deposit is required at the time of registration for riding participants. For riding participants, one auditor's pass will be provided. The first 15 complete applications for riding participants will be accepted. RV Hookups available for \$17 a night.

## Facilities

The Ned R. McWherter Agricultural Complex will house the clinic. The 82,000 square-foot building includes seating for 3,200 people a 178 stall heated stalling barn, a 110 x 250 heated indoor arena, and an outdoor practice arena. Stalling and bedding is included in the participation fee.
