Austin Peay at UT Martin

Jason Simpson, the fourth-year head football coach at The University of Tennessee at Martin, has challenged his Skyhawks to pay off a debt to the team's 18 seniors today when they close out the 2009 season at Hardy M. Graham Stadium on campus against Austin Peay. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m.

"We owe it to our seniors to go out and win today," Simpson said. "Guys like Joe Gibbs, Brandyn Young, Cade Thompson and Marquis Guy have given a lot to this team and we have to pay them back."

The Skyhawks will honor the seniors before today's kickoff at 12:40 p.m.

Four-year seniors like Gibbs and Guy have helped the Skyhawks win a share of the 2006 Ohio Valley Conference championship; advance to postseason play for the first time since 1988; win 19 OVC games; and 25 overall games.

Skyhawk-Gov Notes

Non-scholarship football - Austin Peay played rejoined the Ohio Valley Conference as a football playing school in 2007. Prior to 2007, the Govs played non-scholarship football and were a member of the Pioneer League. The Govs are 10-13 since rejoining the OVC.

Simpson's OVC record - Be careful when you figure coach Jason Simpson's record in the Ohio Valley Conference. Simpson is 19-11 vs. the OVC since becoming the Skyhawks' head coach in 2006. While the Skyhawks and Govs played in 2006, the game was not an OVC contest. Simpson is 26-20 in his four years as the head coach at UT Martin.

Austin Peay's Christophel - Govs head coach Rick Christophel is in his third year at Austin Peay. He sports a 13-19 overall record and is 10-13 in the OVC. Christophel is an Austin Peay alumnus. His brother, Rob Christophel, is the offensive coordinator at Missouri State, a team the Skyhawks played earlier this season.

Sgt. York Trophy series - This will be the third year UT Martin has competed for the coveted Sgt. York Trophy, an annual trophy awarded to the winner of the season football series between the four Tennessee schools in the Ohio Valley Conference, Austin Peay, Tennessee Tech, Tennessee State and UT Martin. Tennessee State has won the Sgt. York trophy the past two seasons. Today's UT Martin, Austin Peay game is the third in the Sgt. York trophy series for the Skyhawks this season. Tennessee Tech has already clinched the trophy this year by virtue of victories over Austin Peay, Tennessee State and UT Martin. UT Martin is 1-1 in the series this year with a win over TSU and a loss to Tennessee Tech. The Sgt. York trophy is awarded at the annual Nashville Sports Council's O'Charley's Dinner of Champions. The award is named in honor of Alvin C. York, the most noted soldier of World War I. UT Martin is 4-4 in Sgt. York trophy games.

Former Skyhawks Take On New Roles

Five former Skyhawks will have new roles for the 2009 season. The UT Martin alums include Brandon Cooper, Kevin Bannon and Ray Williams. Cooper is an assistant coach who will work with defensive backs, while Bannon and Williams are graduate assistants.

Chip Martin and Jerrod Grace are now working as managers. Martin was last year's long snapper, while Grace was a mainstay on the defensive line.

New Coaches, New Assignments

Head football coach Jason Simpson has announced the addition of two new assistant coaches and several coaching assignment changes.

Simpson has added Jimmy Lindsey and Will Harriger to the staff. Lindsey, who comes to UT Martin from Miami of Ohio, will coach the defensive line. Harriger, who was a graduate assistant coach for Simpson during the 2006 Ohio Valley Conference Championship season, is now a full-time assistant and will coach linebackers.

Offensive line coach Geep Wade will now serve as the team's offensive coordinator. Other changes include Gerad Parker moving from running backs to wide receivers, while Adam Beauchamp will coach the running backs after spending his first season with the Skyhawks as the defensive line coach.

Memphis, Tennessee On Schedule

UT Martin will continue to play Football Bowl Subdivision teams for the next two seasons. The Skyhawks will play Memphis, a member of Conference USA, on Sept. 19 at the Liberty Bowl in Memphis.

In 2010, the Skyhawks will make their first trip ever to Neyland Stadium to play the Tennessee Volunteers, a member of the Southeastern Conference. The Tennessee game is set for Sept. 4, 2010.

This past season the Skyhawks played South Florida, a member of the Big East Conference at Raymond James Stadium in Tampa and Southeastern Conference power Auburn at Jordan-Hare Stadium in Auburn, Ala.

They're Back

Offensive lineman Nick O'Rick is back. O'Rick suffered a knee injury in the first half of the 2007 season opener at Southern Miss. He missed the remainder of the 2007 season and the entire 2008 season recovering from the injury.

Linebacker, now fullback, Josh Frohock missed spring practice because of a knee injury. Frohock suffered a knee injury at the end of the 2008 spring practice and missed the entire 2008 season. This spring he injured the other knee on the third practice, and had surgery early enough to return in time for the 2009 season opener against Iowa Wesleyan.

UT Martin By The Numbers From Game 9

- The Skyhawks are 3-1 this season when they score first.
- Senior quarterback Cade Thompson scored his third career rushing touchdown in the second quarter. He was also 11 of 22 in passing for 115 yards.
- Senior Brandyn Young scored his sixth and seventh touchdowns of the season. Young is the team's second leading scorer with 44 points this season. Young also record his first 100-yard rushing game of the season. He carried the ball 32 times for 129 yards and two touchdowns.
- Senior defensive back Marquis Guy made his first and second interceptions of the year in the first half. He also had two pass breakups in the game.
- Junior defensive end Justin Darden had three solo tackles in the win over TSU. He had two TFL of 15 yards and a fumble recovery with a 65-yard return, the longest of the season for UT Martin. He also had a QBH. Darden and the Skyhawk defense recorded 10 TFL of 43 yards.
- The Skyhawk defense limited TSU to 49 total yards of offense in the first half and just eight yards of rushing. The Skyhawks allowed only 62 yards of rushing in the game.

Season-ending injuries

- UT Martin senior linebacker Sione Fale'ofa suffered a season-ending knee injury against Memphis (Sept. 19, 2009) and will more than likely miss the rest of the season. Fale'ofa was fourth on the team in total tackles with 12 after three games.
- UT Martin junior return specialist and wide receiver Bryant Milligan, a transfer from Marshall University, will miss the final two games of the season after breaking his right fibula against host Tennessee State (Nov. 7, 2009)

A chance to win a share of the OVC title

The University of Tennessee at Martin cannot claim the Ohio Valley Conference's automatic bid to the Football Championship Playoffs, but the Skyhawks can claim a share of the league title, their second since 2006. Here's what has to happen ...

- UT Martin must win its last two games (at Eastern Illinois and vs. Austin Peay)
- Eastern Illinois must lose its last two games (vs. UT Martin and vs. Tennessee State)
- Eastern Kentucky must lose to Jacksonville State

The composite tiebreaker would look like this ...

- Eastern Kentucky would be 2-0
- UT Martin would be 1-1
- Eastern Illinois would be 0-2.

Thompson chasing history

Senior quarterback Cade Thompson passed for 286 yards against Tennessee Tech (Oct. 10, 2009) to join elite company in The University of Tennessee at Martin football history. Thompson is only the second quarterback in school history to surpass the 5,000 passing yard mark. He joins Brady Wahlberg (2002-05) as the only other quarterback to throw for over 5,000 yards. Wahlberg threw for 6,247 yards as a four-year starter.

1,000 Yard Rushing Club

Senior running back Miguel Barnes became UT Martin's 20th all-time leading rusher and a member of the 1,000-yard club after rushing for 98 yards against Tennessee Tech (Oct. 10, 2009). Barnes, who has 1,164 rushing yards through his 20 career games at UT Martin, has tallied more than 90 yards rushing in six games, including five in 2009. Four of his five 90+ yard games have come against OVC schools.

Thompson, Wahlberg in heated battle for best UTM signal-caller

Senior quarterback Cade Thompson and former UT Martin quarterback Brady Wahlberg are in quite a battle for the argument of best Skyhawk signal-caller in program history. The two are in a heated race to see who is No. 1 and No. 2 in almost all of the all-time program passing categories.

Thompson entered the season barely edging Wahlberg in career pass completion percentage, as Thompson's 59.8 completion percentage bested Wahlberg's 59.3 career rate. Through the season's first seven games, Thompson has extended his career mark to 61.1 percent, but with a run of bad breaks, Wahlberg could also overtake Thompson by season's end. If Thompson continues at his current season's pace (63.6 percent in 2009), he will pose as a threat to another one of the all-time UT Martin greats, Leon Reed (1987-

88), for best completion percentage in a single-season. Reed's 63.7 percent rate in 1987 has stood as the best all-time mark for 22 years and counting.

Wahlberg was accountable for 51 touchdowns in his four seasons at UT Martin - the most ever by a quarterback in Skyhawk history. Thompson currently sits at 43 touchdowns, needing nine over the next four games. In his career, Thompson has thrown for eight touchdowns against Murray State, two against Tennessee State, zero against Eastern Illinois and three against Austin Peay - the next four opponents.

In terms of passing yardage, Wahlberg stands 874 yards ahead of Thompson in the all-time career record books. To eclipse that number, Thompson would have to average 219 passing yards per game for the season's last four games.

In his career, Thompson has thrown for at least 219 yards in 13 of his 29 games, including nine of 20 Ohio Valley Conference games.

Barring a record hot-streak in a pass-only offense from Thompson, Wahlberg - who played for UT Martin from 2002-05 - will stay in the lead of three all-time UT Martin passing categories.

Thompson needs 296 passing attempts (74 per game) and 163 completed passes (40.8 per game) to catch Wahlberg in those statistical categories. It's also pretty safe to assume Wahlberg will not relinquish the title of having the most total offensive yards in a career. Wahlberg was one of 20 all-time 1,000 yard rushers at UT Martin and finished his career with 7,387 yards of total offense. Although Thompson did collect his first career rushing touchdown at Eastern Kentucky (Oct. 17), he has -251 career rushing yards.

CHARLESTON, Ill. - Eastern Illinois quarterback Jake Christensen erased any chance The University of Tennessee at Martin football team had of winning a share of the Ohio Valley

Conference championship Saturday afternoon. The southpaw transfer from Iowa threw four touchdown passes and completed 18 of 21 attempts for 322 yards and led the host Panthers to a 49-13 victory over the Skyhawks.

For No. 13 Eastern Illinois the victory marked the 12th time in 15 meetings it has defeated the Skyhawks. UT Martin has never defeated EIU here at O'Brien Stadium.

The UT Martin defense gave up 10 plays of 15 yards or more in the game. Christensen was able to pass for first downs on nine of the 10 plays.

Eastern Illinois scored three third quarter touchdowns, two passing and one on the ground. Jimmy Potempa hauled in a 3-yard pass for a TD with 9:08 remaining in the quarter, while Charles Graves caught his second touchdown pass of the game, a 45-yard pass from Christensen. Chevon Walker scored the third touchdown of the quarter, a 10-yard run that capped off a 55-yard drive.

The Skyhawks opened the fourth quarter with a 10-play scoring drive that covered 85 yards. Redshirt freshman Jason McNair capped the drive off with a 16-yard touchdown run, his fifth of the season.

Eastern Illinois dominated the first half scoring twice in the first quarter and twice in the second quarter. The Panthers marched 71 yards in eight plays to score on the first possession of the game. Mon Williams capped the drive off with a 2-yard run.

CJ James picked off a Cade Thompson pass and raced 79 yards for a touchdown to give the Panthers a 14-0 advantage with 7:39 to play in the opening quarter.

The Skyhawks finally mounted an offensive drive. They marched 82 yards in 10 plays and senior Miguel Barnes scored on a 2-yard run to make it a 14-7.

EIU opened the second quarter with a 27-yard pass from Christensen to Lorence Ricks for a touchdown. The Panthers closed out the second quarter with another Christensen pass, this time a 9-yard scoring strike to Charles Graves.

EIU rolled up 251 yards of total offense in the first half, 206 via Christensen. The Panthers scored on their first three possessions of the game. They were driving on their fourth possession but coughed the ball up at the UT Martin 16 yard line. UT Martin senior

UT Martin Head Coach Jason Simpson

It didn't take Jason Simpson long to move the UT Martin football team into the upper echelon of the Ohio Valley Conference.

After three seasons, Simpson sports a .696 winning percentage, behind Eastern Kentucky's Dean Hood; Jacksonville State's Jack Crow; and Eastern Illinois' Bob Spoo.

Simpson is 16-7 in the OVC and after three seasons he has one OVC championship and came within a field goal of a second championship this past season. He has led the Skyhawks to the Football Championship Subdivision postseason for the first time in school history (2006) and his teams have been ranked among the top 25 in the nation annually.

Simpson begins his fourth season with the Skyhawks ranked 13th in the nation by *Lindy's Magazine*. He also enters his fourth season with the second best won-loss percentage in all games among current OVC coaches.

Simpson is 22-14 overall and has a .611 winning percentage. He is second to ECU's Hood who was 8-4 in his inaugural season. Simpson and Hood matched strategies in the 2008 season finale. ECU won the game when it blocked the Skyhawks' 45-yard field goal with four seconds left on the clock. Prognosticators say this year's Oct. 17 game in Richmond between the Skyhawks and Colonels could determine the OVC crown.

Simpson and the Skyhawks finished the 2008 campaign with an 8-4 overall record and a 6-2 OVC worksheet. The team received votes in both the FCS Coaches Poll and the Sports Network Poll, and was ranked 25th in the nation in the final Sports Media Entertainment (SME) Network poll.

The team was ranked fourth in the nation in scoring offense (37.33) and sixth in fumbles recovered (16). The Skyhawks were also ranked among the nation's top 40 teams in rushing offense (34), passing offense (35), total offense (16), punt returns (23), kickoff returns (38), passing efficiency (27), sacks (19), tackles for loss (7), third down conversion percentage (8) and fourth down conversion percentage (8).

The head coach had five first team All-OVC selections including quarterback Cade Thompson, wide receiver Mike Hicks, offensive lineman Kevin Bannon, defensive lineman Ray Williams and defensive back Dontrell Miller.

Miller earned All-American honors from the Associated Press, the AFCA and the Sports Network. He was also included in CSN's Fabulous 50 team. Williams picked up honorable mention All-American honors from The Sports Network.

In 2007, the Skyhawks closed out the season by winning four of their last five games. The Skyhawk offense exploded in the second half of the season with a 76-34 victory over Murray State and a 55-20

thumping over Southeast Missouri State.

While the second half of the season was loaded with excitement, the first half was a challenge to say the least. The Skyhawks lost their first three OVC games by a combined nine points.

The team finished the season with a 4-7 overall record and a 4-4 mark in the OVC. Linebacker Josh Yarbrough led the team in tackles and earned All-OVC honors and honorable mention All-American honors from the Sports Network. Running back Don Chapman closed out his career as UT Martin's all-time rushing leader with 5,017 yards. Chapman became only the 14th Division I player to rush for 1,000 yards in four consecutive seasons. Return specialist Jessie "Juice" Burton was the Sports Network's third best kick returner. Burton was invited to the Canadian Football League's Calgary Stampeders training camp.

In 2006, Simpson's first year, the Skyhawks posted a 9-3 overall record and a 6-1 mark in the OVC standings. The overall worksheet was the best for the Skyhawks since 1988 when they advance to postseason play as a Division II team. The six OVC victories were the most for the Skyhawks since joining the league in 1992. Of the nine victories, five were road wins and it marked the first time the Skyhawks won an OVC road game since 1996.

Along with wins, Simpson led the Skyhawks to national rankings for the first time since 1989 and top 10 statistical rankings in pass efficiency defense (2), total defense (6), pass defense (7). The team was 12th in rushing offense while Chapman was ranked No. 9 in rushing offense (128.36 yards per game). Burton was ranked seventh in kickoff returns (26.2 yards per return).

Simpson finished fourth in the annual voting for the Eddie Robinson Award, the nation's best coach. He was named the American Football Coaches Association Region 3 Coach of the Year and he earned the OVC's Roy Kidd Coach of the Year trophy.

Before accepting his first head coaching job at UT Martin, Simpson was the offensive coordinator at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He was instrumental in the resurgence of the UTC football program. In 2005, Chattanooga posted a 6-5 campaign, the school's first winning season since 1997.

Before Chattanooga, Simpson coached at Texas State University, a member of the Southland Football League. He coached quarterbacks, receivers and served as the team's recruiting coordinator. At Texas State, Simpson coached Tyson Olivo who is the school's third all-time receptions leader. In 2000, Texas State posted a 7-4 record, the school's first winning season in 10 years.

Simpson served as an assistant coach from 1997-1999 at Jacksonville State University.

He coached quarterbacks and was the team's pass records.



Simpson is a native of Ellisville, Miss. He signed as a quarterback with Mississippi State and played for two seasons for the Bulldogs. He also played baseball for Ron Polk at State before transferring to Southern Miss in 1992. At Southern Miss, Simpson was a two-time all-conference selection in baseball and was team captain his senior season. After earning a bachelor's degree in 1994 from Southern Miss, he spent the next year as a graduate assistant football coach at Delta State, where he coached defensive backs. In the spring of 1995, Simpson served as an assistant football and head baseball coach at Collins High School in Mississippi.

Simpson and his wife, the former Julie Wilkerson, have two sons and a daughter: Ty, 6 years old,
