**#3 Danielle Rogers**  
Junior, Defender  
Orland Park, Ill.



Rogers earned her second consecutive All-Ohio Valley Conference first team mention on Wednesday night at the OVC awards banquet. In addition to her first team honor, Rogers was also named OVC Defensive Player of the Year, the first UT Martin player to ever win that award.

Rogers, who also earned a spot on the All-OVC Tournament team last season, has helped lead the Skyhawk defense to new heights in 2009, as they ranked as high as 20th in the nation in the NCAA Division-I goals against average statistical rankings. The Skyhawks have allowed a program-low 12 goals so far through 15 matches, with only five of those coming in eight OVC matches.

Rogers also was a two-time OVC Defensive Player of the Week (Sept. 15 and Sept. 22) in 2009 and also pushed up to score two goals and record an assist this season.

**LEADING OFF**

The UT Martin Skyhawks will look to advance to its second straight Ohio Valley Conference Tournament championship match on Friday night, when they will take on the Murray State Racers in the OVC Tournament semifinals from Jayne Stadium in Morehead, Ky.

The Skyhawks are coming off its first-ever OVC regular-season championship, as a 1-0 win over Eastern Illinois in Terre Haute, Ind. on Halloween gave UT Martin a co-championship with Morehead State.

The last time these two teams met was on Oct. 4. On a chilly, wet afternoon at Skyhawk Field, the UT Martin offense caught fire in the first half of play - scoring two goals in the first stanza - and the defense held its ground in a 2-0 victory. Freshman goalkeeper Aubrey Buehler made all three of her saves over the last 45 minutes of play to ensure the victory.

The Skyhawks trail the all-time series with Murray State 2-7-1, but UT Martin will look to carry over its success against Murray State earlier this season, as the 2-0 win over the Racers earlier this season was the first time the Skyhawks had beat the Racers since a 4-2 decision on Oct. 12, 2003. The two teams have never faced each other at a neutral site.

**SCOUTING MURRAY STATE**

The Racers might have been the league's second-hottest team to finish the regular-season, as they won three straight matches before falling to future OVC member SIU Edwardsville at home 2-1 on Nov. 1.

Murray State put three members on the 2009 All-OVC first team in defender Veronika Pribyslavska, midfielder Nicole Evans and midfielder Sophie Hargreaves.

In addition to making the All-OVC second team and All-OVC Newcomer team, Danielle McMurray also earned OVC Freshman of the Year.

On offense, the Racers boast four players who ended the regular-season with double-digit points, as Hargreaves, McMurray, Evans and Kalli McCoy each scored five goals apiece. In goal, Tara Isbell posted a 1.21 overall GAA, but didn't allow a goal in OVC play.

The Racers are guided by Beth Acreman, who is in her fourth season at the helm of the Murray State soccer program.

## CRAIG ROBERTS

### Head Coach

### Fourth Season

Craig Roberts, a native of Kidderminster, England, is in his fourth season at the helm of the women's soccer program at The University of Tennessee at Martin.

Roberts, who has a track record of quickly turning struggling programs into contenders, has led the Skyhawks to back-to-back historical seasons. In addition to setting the program's record for wins in a single season with 10 for two straight seasons, Roberts also has guided the Skyhawks to its first two Ohio Valley Conference Tournament wins and advanced to the conference semifinals (2007) and conference finals (2008) for the first time ever.

In 2008, Roberts watched his team advance all the way to the OVC championship, en route to breaking or tying 12 program records, after breaking nine in 2007. The Skyhawks boasted a nationally-ranked defense and had three All-OVC players, and five OVC player of the week honorees, including one in four consecutive weeks.

UT Martin's historical 2007 season was enough to earn the distinction as the 16th most improved team in NCAA Division I. This was the second time in Roberts' coaching career that he has been part of such a turnaround, also helping resurrect the Virginia Military Institute's program. Under Roberts' direction, a duo of Skyhawks earned All-OVC accolades in 2007, while also earning conference player of the week honors twice in 2007.

In his inaugural season, Roberts guided UT Martin to its first Ohio Valley Conference tournament appearance since 2003 after arriving on campus only four weeks prior to the season's beginning. Under Roberts' direction the Skyhawks' defense produced seven shutouts, the most in school history for a single season. That benchmark also included a stretch of six consecutive games that spanned over 656 minutes of scoreless soccer from Skyhawk opponents. UT Martin also returned players to the All-OVC first team under Roberts, while for the first time putting a player on the OVC All-Newcomer team along with receiving first ever national recognition in the form of a SoccerBuzz Goalkeeper of the Week nod.

Roberts currently holds three bachelor's degrees in biology, athletic training and education along with a master's degree in education, all from

Park University. Roberts is currently pursuing a master's of kinesiology from Saint Mary's College. Roberts also holds his USSF 'A' License, NSCAA Premier License, NSCAA Goal keeping License, NSCAA Youth Specialist License and English F.A. Premier Coaching License.

Roberts comes from a family with a pedigree of high level soccer performance. Roberts' father, Gordon Roberts, played for the Wolverhampton Wanderers along with serving as captain of the Welsh National Team in the mid '60s.



# SKYHAWK NEWS AND NOTES

## BLESSING IN DISGUISE?

Although the Skyhawks did share the 2009 Ohio Valley Conference title, Morehead State earned the right to host the tournament, due to its 3-2 win over UT Martin on Oct. 18. UT Martin did go 6-1 at home in 2009, but recent history is not on the host team's side in the OVC Tournament. Six of the 10 OVC Tournaments have been won by the host team, but none of the host teams have taken home the title in the last three attempts.

## FOUR SKYHAWKS EARN ALL-OVC HONORS

Four UT Martin players won six different OVC awards at the postseason banquet on Wednesday night, headlined by junior Danielle Rogers winning the OVC Defensive Player of the Year. Rogers also earned first team honors, and was joined on the first team by junior midfielder Brooke Robertson.

Freshman forward Kendyl Wilson was named to the All-OVC second team, and also earned a place on the All-Newcomer team. Freshman goalkeeper Aubrey Buehler also was rewarded for her strong play, being named to the All-Newcomer team.

## SKYHAWKS CLINCH SHARE OF FIRST-EVER OVC TITLE

With the 1-0 win on Halloween night over Eastern Illinois, the Skyhawks clinched its first-ever OVC co-championship in program history. It looks to be the beginning of a truly historical season for UT Martin, as they are now just one win shy of tying the all-time program record for single-season wins, which they have set in each of the last two seasons under head coach Craig Roberts.

season with a perfect 6-0 record at home before the 3-2 loss to Morehead State on Oct. 18. With the 6-0 start, the Skyhawks matched the best home start to any season and ended with the best home record for one season. In 2005, the team won its first six home matches and finished the year 8-2 at home. Head coach Craig Roberts is 23-7-2 (.750) in his career at home, including a 19-3-1 (.848) record over the last three years.

## UTM BALANCED SCORING ATTACK

Through the season's first 15 matches, a total of 16 different Skyhawks have scored at least one point, while 13 different players have netted at least one goal. In 2008, nine players recorded at least one goal and 14 different players scored a point. The Skyhawks also have converted on all three of its penalty kick attempts this year, with Stephanie Nilica going 2-for-2.

## BUEHLER EARNS TRUST IN GOAL

True freshman Aubrey Buehler truly had some big shoes to fill entering this season, replacing senior Johanna Rathbun, who is found throughout the UT Martin record book atop most goalkeeping categories. The freshman has more than held her own, playing all but 49:43 in goal through the season's first 15 matches, tallying a career-high eight saves against Eastern Kentucky on Oct. 16. Buehler has compiled five conference shutouts so far in 2009. Buehler has made four or more saves in seven matches so far this season.

## UTM WINS NINTH STRAIGHT PUMA INVITE MATCH

The 2009 PUMA Skyhawk Invitational title went to UT Martin, who went undefeated in the two-day, four-team event which began in 2002 and was in

its seventh season overall.

On the tournament's opening day, the Skyhawks defeated Missouri-Kansas City 3-0, holding UMKC to zero shot attempts - the first time in program history that had happened.

UT Martin boasted tournament MVP Danielle Rogers, and Jenni Duffy, Tori Taylor, and Brooke Robertson were all named to the all-tournament team for their outstanding play.

## A LONG WAY FROM HOME...

The Skyhawks recently concluded its first-ever trip to the Sunshine State, competing 1,008 miles away from Martin in the Embassy Suites Kick-off Classic hosted by Florida Gulf Coast University in Fort Myers, Fla. However, long trips have been common under head coach Craig Roberts.

In 2006, the Skyhawks took part in the Northern Arizona Invitational in Flagstaff, Ariz., which is 1,473 miles from Martin. The next year, Roberts took the team out of the mainland to

compete in the Outrigger Hotels Soccer Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii - a 5,155 mile trip from campus. Last season, the Skyhawks traveled to Stockton, Calif. for the Pacific Fall Tournament - which led the team 2,186 miles from the friendly confines of Martin.

## PRESIDENTIAL TERRITORY

When the Skyhawks and Belmont began its match at the Whitten Soccer Complex, it was the first official match that had taken place there since late 2007. The field was vacant last season because of the 2008 Presidential Town Hall Debate between Barack Obama and John McCain last Oct. 7, where various television and other media took up most of the space all across sections of Belmont's campus. To adjust, Belmont played all of its home games at three different locations in 2008.

## GONE IN 60 SECONDS

UT Martin started its 2009 season off quickly against Lipscomb on Aug. 28, as Kendyl Wilson scored the season's first goal right at the 1:00 mark.

The goal was the third-fastest goal to begin a match in program history, as Kendal Keim scored a goal in the first 17 seconds of a 2-1 home win against Arkansas State on Sept. 12, 2004, and Ginger Parson scored off an assist from Dani Myrick in the first 36 seconds in a 10-1 home win over Morehead State on Oct. 11, 2002.

Wilson has shown a nose for the ball throughout the season, as she also recorded a two-goal game against Eastern Kentucky on Oct. 16. The Collierville native also scored the lone goal in the 1-0 win over Eastern Illinois to give the Skyhawks a share of the OVC title.

## SKYHAWK TEAM CAPTAINS NAMED

Junior defender Danielle Rogers and senior midfielder Jamie Furstenberg have been named co-captains for the 2009 season. Rogers earned All-OVC first team honors last season as well as a

spot on the All-OVC Tournament Team in 2008, while Furstenberg also warranted a spot on the All-OVC Tournament team in 2008.

This marks the fourth time in head coach Craig Roberts' tenure that the Skyhawks have had two captain representatives, as the team has had two captains for each of the past three seasons.

## SKYHAWKS FOREVER YOUNG

For the second consecutive season, the Skyhawks brought in a double-digit freshman class. Eleven new faces joined the Skyhawks in 2008, and this season's incoming recruiting class included 10 players. With that said, 19 of the 25 players on the Skyhawks roster in 2009 are underclassmen.

However, the eight returning players from the Class of 2008 left a huge mark on the program. The eight players combined for 14 of the team's 21 goals, and four of the team's 18 assists for 32 of the team's 60 points. An even more amazing stat is that the 2008 freshmen provided nine of the team's 10 game-winning goals.

No doubt, the 10 Skyhawk freshmen have held their own this season, producing 19 of the team's 62 total points (31 percent) off seven goals and five assists.

The Skyhawk goalkeeper situation would likely be dramatically different without the strong play of freshmen Aubrey Buehler and Linnis McMahan, as the duo have combined for a GAA of 0.85, making 44 saves and combining for seven shutouts.
