HEAD COACH DARRIN McCLURE



Darrin McClure enters his fourth season at the helm of The University of Tennessee at Martin volleyball program. Having previously served as an assistant coach in 2005 and 2006 seasons, then guiding the program back to the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament for the first time in six seasons as interim head coach for the 2008 campaign, McClure was officially named the program's sixth head coach January 13, 2009.

McClure's coaching philosophy is based off a famous quote from Vince Lombardi: "Excellence is achieved by the mastery of fundamentals."

"I believe that when we work hard and become diligent at the basics, the game as a whole becomes easier," McClure said. "We spend a lot of time in practice working on fundamentals and I always challenge my players to see the real world application that can be learned through sports."

McClure takes pride in seeing his student-athletes lead successful lives after they have finished their playing careers.

"While obviously I want a team full of players who can produce on the volleyball court, I also want good people and good students," McClure said. "Very few college volleyball players will go on to compete professionally, so I stress the importance of earning a degree and getting a good education while they are at UT Martin. When a player finishes her career playing under me it is my desire that two things occur: they still have a love and passion for the game and they are more capable to function in the real world because of the experiences gained as a student-athlete in our program."

In his first season guiding the program on an interim basis, McClure was able to bring in a talented recruiting class that contributed from day one. That paired with a core group of returners helped him lead the Skyhawks to a 9-24 overall record but more impressively a 7-11 OVC mark, which matched the most conference wins for the program since winning the league in 2002 with a 15-1 OVC record. He also guided UT Martin back to the OVC Tournament, which hadn't been done since the 2002 season.

McClure then took the nation's youngest team in his second season through the year with an 8-21 record. Included in that record was a five-set win over Indiana to open the Indiana Adidas Classic.

Last season, McClure coached Lauren Montague, who graduated as one of the all-time greats in Skyhawk history. She became the seventh player to record 1,000 career kills last season, and graduated as one of three players in program history to finish their career in the top-10 career lists in kills and digs.

McClure also coached UT Martin's first-ever OVC Defensive Player of the Year in Kasey Elswick in 2010. In her first two seasons, Elswick has established herself as one of the best players in Skyhawk history - amassing 1,011 career digs to become one of seven players in the 1,000 Dig Club.

While at UT Martin, McClure's teams have given back to the community in a big way. The Skyhawks have raised more than \$5,000 over three seasons in the fight against breast cancer and Lou Gehrig's Disease.

Prior to returning to his undergraduate alma mater in a head coaching capacity, McClure was a history teacher at Martin Middle School. At the same time he also directed the volleyball program at the University School of Jackson and guided them through the rebuilding process after graduating a wealth of talent from their district championship squad. With a majority of freshmen and sophomores on the floor, he guided USJ to a third-place showing in his first year at the helm.

Additionally, McClure also coached the Jackson Juniors Club Team to a second-place finish in the region. The Jackson Juniors were formally known as the Gotcha Volleyball Club, which he was a co-founder of in 2004.

McClure gained valuable playing experience prior to joining the UT Martin volleyball program. He played middle blocker and outside hitter for the Paducah Volleyball Club for five years from 1994-99 and guided them to a pair of tournament victories. He was also part of the Spike-It-Up Amateur Volleyball Tour that competed 2v2 competition throughout the Southeast and Midwest. He helped guide his Spike-It-Up team to its highest finish of third during a tour stop in Cincinnati, Ohio.

During the off-season, McClure has twice attended the Gold Medal Squared Coaching Camp, an elite coaching clinic conducted by former US Olympic team coach Carl McGowan and two-time Olympic gold medal winning coach Marv Dumphy. He and some of the top collegiate coaches in the nation worked with the Olympic pair to learn from their proven coaching and motivational techniques.

McClure is married to his wife Jennifer, who is also a graduate of UT Martin and the couple has one son, Miles.
