ADMISSIONS APPLICATION TO THE CLINICAL NURSING PROGRAM

For full consideration, an **application must be received by February 15th** before the fall semester in which admission to the BSN clinical nursing courses is desired. Application to the university, high school and college transcripts, and all test scores must be on file in the UTM registrar's office by February 1st. A **new** application is required for each year which you request admission to the clinical nursing program. Requests for readmission or advanced standing must be submitted on the appropriate application.

As part of the admission criteria, candidates must submit:

- 1) **Results from the required RN pre-admission exam** before February 15th. **Register and pay for the Pre-Admission Exam (PAX)** at www.nlnonlinetesting.org <<http://www.nlnonlinetesting.org>> (dates and spaces are limited). **Contact the Office of Testing Services at UTM**, located in Clement Hall, Room 211, (731-881-7727) or success@utm.edu **for all other questions about the exam.**
- 2) **A typed double-spaced statement between 250 to 500 words addressing the following:**
 - a. Explain why you selected nursing as a major.
 - b. Identify qualities you possess that will help you succeed in the nursing profession.
 - c. Describe one situation where you overcame a challenge to achieve a personal goal.
