## **MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES:**

### **Students:**

A current, full-time UT Martin student may use all recreational facilities (arena floor, fieldhouse floor, pool, racquetball courts, walk/jog balcony, and fitness center) by presenting their student ID card at the proper check-in locations. Students are also eligible to purchase recreation cards for their families (spouse and/or children ONLY). Spouses and children (18 & under) have access to the same facilities with the exception of the student fitness center. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by their parents or someone 16 years or older to gain access to the facility. Members who have access to gym floors are allowed to bring two guests for \$3 per visit/per person.

### **Faculty/Staff:**

Full-time UT Martin faculty and staff may use all recreational facilities with the exception of the student fitness center by presenting their UT Martin faculty/staff ID card at the proper check-in locations. With the purchase of a recreation card, spouses and children have access to the same facilities. Faculty/staff children must follow the specified age guidelines. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by their parents or someone 16 years or older to gain access to the facility. Children above the age of 18 and grandchildren of faculty/staff are not eligible for this discount. Members who have access to gym floors are allowed to bring two guests for \$3 per visit/per person.

### **UT Martin Retirees:**

Retired UT Martin faculty and staff may use all recreational facilities with the exception of the student fitness center by presenting their recreation card at the proper check-in location. With the purchase of a recreation card, spouses also have access to the same facilities. Children above the age of 18 and grandchildren of retirees are not eligible for this discount. Members who have access to gym floors are allowed to bring two guests for \$3 per visit/per person.

### **Community (Limited Recreation Pass)**

This membership allows access to two recreational areas: the swimming pool and the racquetball courts. We do not offer memberships to the weight room and gym floors. Members must present their recreation card at the proper check-in locations. Children under 14 years of age must be accompanied by their parents or someone 16 years or older to gain access to the facility.

### **Senior Citizens:**

Individuals 60 and older qualify for the senior discount. This membership allows access to two recreational areas: the swimming pool and the racquetball courts. We do not offer memberships to the weight room or gym floors. Members must present their recreation card at the proper check-in locations.

### **Guest Fees:**

Guests may purchase a daily pass (pool, racquetball and gym floors) for \$3.00. However, guests can only access gym floors when accompanied by a student, faculty/staff or retiree member.

## **ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS**

In order to gain access to the facility, an individual must possess one of the following:

1. Current Student ID.
  2. Faculty/Staff ID/Retiree ID.
  3. Community Recreation Card.
  4. Daily Pass: \$ 3 for pool/ \$3 for racquetball/ \$3 for guest with member to gain access to arena floor (2 guests per member).
  5. Camp/Special Guest Pass approved by professional staff (examples Governor's School, 4H Camp, Guest Speakers).
  6. Complimentary recreational pass.
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- A. All participants are required to carry their I.D. or Recreational Sports pass with them at all times while using the facility. Only the identification cards mentioned above will be accepted as valid.
  - B. Any questions involving fees or eligible participant policies should be brought to the attention of a professional staff member.
  - C. Daily pass purchases may not be applied to an annual pass.
