Admission

All persons desiring to attend the University of Tennessee at Martin must be “officially” admitted. UT Martin offers regular admission, non-traditional adult admission, conditional admission, early admission, concurrent admission, dual-credit admission (for participating high schools) and special admission (non-degree seeking, transfer admission, or re-admission).

If you are a first-time or transfer student, you are encouraged to begin this process at least one month prior to the beginning date of classes in order to allow time to provide all needed documentation. You will need to complete an application for admission, pay an application fee of \$30, provide a copy of ACT scores to the Admissions Office, and have a high school transcript forwarded to the Admissions Office that includes all courses taken during your senior year. Transfer students must have transcripts forwarded from each institution attended, including high school.

If you are a returning student, not enrolled Fall 2007, re-admission is required. You must complete an application for admission, but you are not required to pay the application fee. If you have attended another college(s) since your last enrollment at UT Martin, all transcript(s) must be forwarded to the Admissions Office. You must meet the high school unit requirements effective at the time of your first enrollment.

If you are a transient student, only enrolling for one semester at UT Martin and returning to your college, you must provide a Statement of Standing from your college to the Admissions Office, complete an application, and pay a \$30 application fee.
