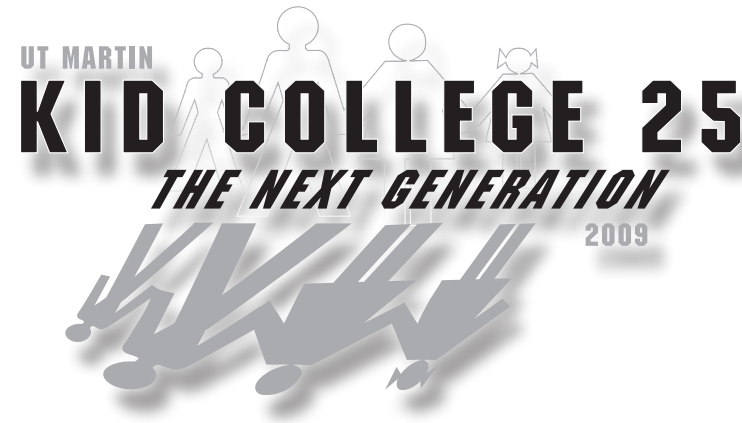

### Dear Moms and Dads...

UT Martin's 9th Annual Kid College is June 15-25. Kid College is a nine-day program for children who will attend Kindergarten in 2009 through the 5th grade. Our goal for Kid College is to provide your child an opportunity to have a fun-learning experience. We have many interesting and exciting courses. You and your child may review the course descriptions and select the course(s) they wish to take based on their interest and the appropriate grade level. Children may register for one to five courses.

To help our program operate smoothly, we have the following reminders:

#### Prior to Kid College

Register your child in advance.  
 Registration & Payment instructions are on the registration form.

Registration fee is \$40 per class.

**T-Shirts.** Kid College T-Shirts are available for an additional \$10.

#### June 15th - First Day

Arrive 15 to 20 minutes prior to your child's first class to pick up his/her Nametag and T-Shirt.

**Supply Fee** - This is to be paid directly to the instructor. Please send the money in an envelope on the first day of Kid College. Write your child's name and either the name of the class or the instructor's name on the outside of the envelope. Send exact cash or make a check payable to the instructor. A few of the courses list things the children can bring from home.

#### After 1st day - June 25th

Arrive 10 minutes prior to class.  
 Nametags should be worn daily. Provide a backpack for supplies. Label everything!

Children will be supervised at all times, including lunch. They will be escorted to and from class at each period and class rolls are checked hourly.

If your child will be staying for lunch, please send their lunch and a drink.

**Drop Off and Pick Up** - Children should be dropped off at the 5th grade wing. Enter the school drive on the north side

and the 5th grade wing will be the third wing. Kid College staff will be there to greet your child. Parents who would like to bring their child inside will need to park in the front parking lot and enter the front entrance and go to the 5th grade wing. Children may not enter through this door without a parent. Children should be picked up at the 5th grade wing. Parents should remain in their cars and Kid College staff will escort the children to the cards. You will be given a sign, with your child's name on it, on the first day of class to place in your window to assist the staff in getting your children to you. Or you may park in the parking lot and enter through the front entrance and come to the 5th grade wing and pick up your children. Children will not be allowed to leave through the front entrance unless the parent comes in and picks them up. Please do not park your car outside the 5th grade wing and come inside. This drive needs to remain open.

#### June 25th

**Open House - 4:30 - 5:30 p.m.** All parents, family and friends are invited to drop by and meet the teachers, view displays and watch demonstrations. Refreshments will be served.
