Admissions Criteria for Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD)

Students will be considered for entry to the DPD based on the following criteria:

- Cumulative GPA = 3.0 or better
- Grade of C or better in each of the following courses:
 - BIOL 140 Foundations of Bio: Cell & Molecular
 - CHEM 121 General Chemistry I
 - CHEM 122 General Chemistry II
 - FSCI 200 Food Principles
 - FSMG 312 Quantity Food Management
 - NUTR 100 Introductory Nutrition
- Completion of application packet, which includes:
 - DPD admission application
 - Current transcripts from UTM and/or any other relevant universities or colleges attended
 - Completion of interview with Dietetics faculty
