18. THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF THE TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED APPLY TO ALL INVITATIONS FOR BID:

Section 12-3-106: Acceptance of gifts from contractors prohibited. No officer or employee of the Department of General Services nor any member of the Board of Standards, nor any head of any state department, institution or agency charged with responsibility of initiating requisitions, shall accept or receive, directly or indirectly, from any person, firm or corporation to whom any contract for the purchase of materials, supplies, or EQUIPMENT for the State of Tennessee may be awarded, by rebate, gifts, or otherwise, any money or anything of value whatsoever, or any promise, obligation or contract for future rewards or compensation.

Section 12-4-101: Personal interest of officers prohibited. It is unlawful for any office, committee member, director, or other person whose duty is to vote for, let out, overlook, or in any manner to superintend any work or any contract in which any municipal corporation, county, or the state, shall or may be interested, to be directly or to be indirectly interested without disclosing such interest in any such contract.

Section 12-4-103: Bidding by State employees prohibited. It is hereby declared unlawful for any state official or employee to bid on, sell or offer for sale, any merchandise, EQUIPMENT or material, or similar commodity to the State of Tennessee during the tenure of his office or employment, or for six (6) months thereafter, or to have any interest in the selling of the same to the state.

19. Completion of this form does not mean that your firm has been approved as a supplier, or that invitations to bid will be sent to your firm. Invitations to bids are publicly posted in the Purchasing Department Reception Room. Copies of those posted invitations will be made available to qualified bidders requesting them.

20. The vendor certifies that he/she is not presently debarred, proposed for debarment, suspended, or declared ineligible for covered transactions by any federal agency or department. The vendor also certifies that within the past three years he/she has not been convicted of or had civil judgment rendered against them for a fraudulent contract or transaction, violation of federal or state antitrust laws, or the commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsifying or destroying records, receiving stolen property, or making false statements.

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**GENERAL REQUIREMENTS OF VENDOR
UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE/MARTIN**

1. Application and Registration -Vendors

Every person or firm desiring to bid on supplies, materials, and EQUIPMENT purchased by the Purchasing Department may submit a Bidder's Application Form for approval as a prospective bidder. The information submitted on the application will determine the eligibility to bid and the types of materials, supplies and EQUIPMENT which the bidder proposes to deliver. The application forms and instructions may be obtained in person or electronically from:

2. Changes in Registration

If a person or firm desires to change its application after the Purchasing Department receives it, changes may be requested by a letter signed by an authorized individual. Incidental correspondence and bids received with different addresses or signatures will not be considered as a request for change.

3. Qualified Bidders List

The Purchasing Department maintains a list of qualified bidders: Invitations to Bid shall be mailed to prospective bidders selected from these files. **Application, approval and registration, does not guarantee the receipt of an Invitation to Bid or the award of any contract.** Invitations to bid are publicly posted and it is the obligation of Bidders to periodically check the bid board. Copies of those posted invitations will be made available to qualified bidders requesting them.

4. Removal from Qualified Bidders List

A qualified bidder shall be required to delete from its application all commodities which cannot be consistently bid. Failure to respond to three consecutive Invitations to Bid will result in the re-evaluation of the application. Reported failure to comply with bids, awards, and/or orders becomes a part of the bidder's application file. Continued failure to respond to Invitations to Bid will result in removal from all commodity groups. Examples of failure to comply include, but are not limited to:

Over shipments	Damaged products
Under shipments	Defective products
Early shipments	Unauthorized substitutions
Late shipments	Billing errors
Failure to ship	Service deficiencies
Shipments not in conformance with specifications	

Other principal causes for temporary or permanent removal from the bid list are:

Unethical practices	Misrepresentation of merchandise
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Failure of a vendor to perform satisfactorily in any of the above areas may result in a vendor's liability for damages to the University of Tennessee. Laws and directives with broad application include, but are not limited to:

Licensing (T.C.A. 62-601)
Non-Discrimination Clause (Ex. Order 37)

5. Improper Sale or Purchase

All contracts are bid and awarded on the basis of good faith. After a term contract has been established, it is prohibited for any department to purchase from any other source except in emergency situations. All vendors shall refrain from attempts to sell items that are listed on contracts with other vendors. If it appears that a contract award is not in the best interest of The University, vendors are requested to communicate directly with the Purchasing Department. Attempts to sell to individual departments by price reductions or sales pressures may result in removal of the vendor from all bid lists.

PERFORMANCE

6. Purchase Order, Authority and Shipment

The successful bidder will receive a Purchase Order or notice of contract award from the Purchasing Department. The Purchase Order number must be shown on all bills of lading, packing slips, back orders, invoices, etc. The receipt of a Purchase Order for one-time purchase authorizes shipment. Shipment against University Contracts is authorized by receipt of Purchase Orders for specific departments. A contractor who delivers an order without a Purchase Order does so at his own risk.

7. New/Used/Altered

All supplies and-EQUIPMENT furnished must be new and in first class condition unless the Invitation to Bid specifically permits offers of used items. Demonstration, previously rented, or re-conditioned items are not considered new. No new or used EQUIPMENT is acceptable if serial numbers or any other manufacturer's identifying label or make has been removed, obliterated or changed in any way.

8. Packaging

All items must be packaged in new packing containers. Packing that meets the requirement of freight shipping and is acceptable to common carriers is acceptable. A packing slip or invoice must accompany all shipments and must reference the Purchase Order number.

9. Back Orders

If it is necessary to back order any items, the vendor should notify the consignee and advise the expected shipping or delivery date. If this date is not acceptable, The University may seek remedies for default.

10. Substitutions

Substitution is defined as shipment of an item that materially conforms to the specifications but is technically different from the item bid. Substitutions shall require the approval of the Purchasing Department. Any supplies delivered that do not meet specifications, may be returned to the vendor at his expense. When a shipment or item is returned, the contractor must make immediate replacement with acceptable merchandise or The University may seek remedies for default.

11. Loss or Damage in Transit

Delivery by a contractor to a common carrier does not constitute delivery to The University. Any claim for loss or damage incurred during delivery shall be between the contractor and the carrier. The University accepts title only after receipt at the F.O.B. delivery point. The receiving department shall note all damages on the freight bill and refuse the merchandise. The contractor shall make immediate replacement of the damaged merchandise or be subject to damages for breach of contract. If damage is to a small portion of a total shipment and the department will not be inconvenienced because of the shortage, the contractor may be permitted by the Purchasing Department to deduct the amount of the damage or loss from his invoice, in lieu of replacement.

12. Freight

F.O.B. points are established for each individual purchase. An Invitation to Bid may specify F.O.B. Martin or another delivery point within the State. The contractor shall prepay freight charges which are shown on the bid and add the amount to the invoice. A copy of the freight bill must be attached to all invoices that include freight charges.

13. Delivery Time

The number of calendar days required for delivery after receipt of order shall be stated in the Invitation to Bid, and when no time is stated in either document, the time shall be two weeks. Shipments must be made within this period, or be in default of which The University may seek remedies.

14. Receipt by University Departments

Shipments will be checked against the receiving copy of the Purchase Order. Quantities, description and units on all shipping documents must match the Purchase Order. If the contract requires grading certificates, USDA Stamps or any other proof of quality, such proof must accompany the shipment.

15. Inspection

All materials, EQUIPMENT and supplies are subject to inspection and test. Items that do not meet specifications will be rejected. Failure to reject upon receipt, however, does not relieve the contractor of liability. When subsequent tests, after receipt, are conducted and when tests reveal a failure to meet specifications, The University may seek damages including, but not limited to, the testing expense, regardless of whether a part or all of the merchandise has been consumed through the testing process.

16. Vendor Complaints

Any deficiencies in products or vendor performance shall be reported to Purchasing by the using department on a Vendor Complaint Form. The Vendor Complaint Form requires an answer to the using department from the Purchasing Department. Vendors who do not respond promptly to Purchasing's notifications are subject to removal from the bid list.

17. Default by Vendor

In case of any default of the contractor, The University of Tennessee may procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for any excess cost in price or handling.

18. Cancellation of Purchase Orders

No cancellation of Purchase Orders may be made except in writing by the Purchasing Department. Orders may be canceled without the consent of the contractor in case of any default of the contractor. A contractor may request cancellation and The University may grant relief if the contractor is prevented from performance by an act of war, order of legal authority, act of God or other unavoidable causes not attributed to the fault or negligence of the contractor. The burden of proof of need of such relief rests with the contractor. All correspondence pertaining to cancellation of a University of Tennessee Purchase Order must be addressed to the Purchasing Department. The Purchasing Department shall have the right to remove from the qualified bid list any contractor who defaults on any contract with The University.

19. Payment Withheld

Payments for any item delivered may be withheld until all requirements of the contract have been complied with in full.
