Responsibilities: Teach general music education and other courses in the music education curriculum. Supervise student teaching and assist department with oversight of music education curriculum. Teach other classes commensurate with departmental needs and individual expertise.

Qualifications: Public school teaching experience required. Experience teaching at the college level desirable. Choral/vocal background preferred. Masters degree required, doctorate preferred.

Appointment: Nine-month, one-year appointment commencing August 1, 2008.

Rank and Salary: Appointment at assistant professor rank with completed doctorate, at instructor level with masters. Salary commensurate with experience.

The University: The University of Tennessee at Martin is a primary campus in the University of Tennessee System. The campus is located in Northwest Tennessee approximately 125 miles north of Memphis and 150 miles west of Nashville. The University of Tennessee at Martin has a combined graduate and undergraduate enrollment of approximately 7,000 students. The emphasis is solidly on excellence in teaching, applied research, and outreach. We seek candidates who demonstrate a similar commitment.

The Department: The Department of Music is accredited by the National Association of Schools of Music. A key component of the Department's mission is a commitment to music education. It has approximately 75 majors with 13 full-time faculty members and four staff members, including a staff accompanist and piano technician.
