



Music Scholarships & Housing Discounts

• Music Majors Only

- **Chancellor's Music Award - \$3000 per year**
 - Eligibility: Minimum ACT score of 22 and a 2.75 GPA; Participation in All-State and/or other exemplary musical experiences such as Interlochen, Governor's School for the Arts, Top Tier DCI or WGI participation, National Youth Orchestra, Significant Soloist Competition Winner, etc. Exceptional audition required
- **Honor Music Award - \$1500 per year**
 - Eligibility: Minimum ACT score of 22 and a 2.75 GPA; Participation in All Region and/or other honors music experiences may be considered. Excellent audition required.
- **Legacy Music Scholarships and Awards - Up to \$2000 per year**
 - The department of music grants more than 20 named scholarships and awards for outstanding musicians who fit the specific criterion. For more information, please ask the applied studio professor and/or the department chair.
- **UTM High School Solo Competition Winners - Up to \$1000 per year**
 - Competition winners who choose to attend UTM as a music major will receive a scholarship up to an additional \$1,000 per year. Competitions are

hosted at events such as Honor Band, Woodwind Day, Brass Day, and Death by Voice.

• **Music Majors and Minors Only**

- **Music Service Scholarship - Up to \$1000 per year**
 - Eligibility: Acceptance to UT Martin and satisfactory audition required.
 - Participation in assigned ensembles and/or accompanying for pianists required.

• **All Campus Musicians**

- **Aviators Marching Band Housing Discounts and Scholarships**
 - A limited number of **Aviators Marching Band Housing Scholarships** are available. The scholarship reduces the cost of on-campus housing by \$500 each semester, for a total reduction of \$1000 per school year. If a student is awarded the housing scholarship, they are obligated to stay in a dorm on campus for the entire school year.
 - ALL members of the Aviators Marching Band receive a **\$250 service award** and all meals are paid for by UTM during the Aviators Band Camp.
- **Additional Music Scholarships for Campus Musicians**
 - Music Service Scholarships may be available. These are awarded on a need basis per the ensemble.

While serving the Blackhearts in the Tour Manager capacity, the band has also toured with the Foo Fighters, the Who, Heart, Aerosmith, Cheap Trick, Boston, Def Leppard, Cyndi Lauper and a host of other acts... Ed's love for UTM Music and the influential role it has played in his life is obvious. This scholarship in Ed's name will be presented to a student who needs financial assistance in pursuing a valuable opportunity in the field of music business and/or the music industry at large. Up to \$500 will be awarded. The amount is subject to the
