Administered by the College University Recycle Council

6 universities around the U.S.

Began in Ohio between OU and Miami OH in 2001

By 2009, over 500 schools from all 50 states and Canada

Competition based on per capita recycling/trash ratio

On a per capita basis, UTM regularly kicks UTK (& MTSU) butt!

Competition runs from 1/17-3/27

At UTM

- Week 1 alone:
- 8,000 pounds cardboard/paper baled
- 500 pounds of plastic (2 bales)
- 86 pounds aluminum cans (1 bale)

btw: since going trayless, the food waste composting has dropped from around 600 lbs/day to 200 lbs/day of food waste added to the compost!

Recyclemania Activities at UTM

- Relying on all students and organizations to recycle in on-campus bins: (NOT dropped off at recycle barn)
 - Paper/Cardboard
 - Aluminum drink cans
 - Glass
 - #1 plastic (juice bottles)(of course other recyclables can be dropped off at barn)
- 2/20 Competition: start collecting/sorting your recyclables now! 10am-2pm dropoff
- 3/1-5: "Take a Dive" for Recycling (sign up for dumpster dive)
 - Sign up your organization for 1 or more 30-minute slots (go to orgsync)
 - M-F, anytime between 11 am-1 pm to sort thru trash collected from around campus and pull out the recyclables. Whichever organization sorts the most recyclables out of the trash wins a cheesy prize! (FRIENDLY smack talk is permitted as your organization outwits, outsorts, out"dives" all the others!! ☺)
- Keep recycling up thru 3/27...and then AFTER, b/c it's good for UTM, Tennessee, and the environment!!
