## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### WHAT IS CLEP?

CLEP (College-Level Examination Program) is a computer-based exam that allows individuals to earn college credit by demonstrating prior knowledge of a subject. The 90 minute exams are composed of multiple-choice questions. Official score reports are available immediately after the test.

### Who can take a CLEP exam?

You do not have to be a UT Martin student in order to take the CLEP tests. If you have not been admitted to UT Martin, CLEP credits will be held in a "CLEP credit bank" and will be included in your college transcript when admission requirements have been met. A University of Tennessee at Martin student will be allowed to take only 30 hours via CLEP examinations. CLEP general exams must be taken within the first 30 hours at a university or college. CLEP subject exams must be taken prior to the last 30 hours at UT Martin.

### When are exam scores received?

Official score reports are available immediately after the test. Your exam scores are also sent to your designated institutions.

### Do CLEP exams affect my GPA?

CLEP scores do not affect your GPA.

### Can I retake a CLEP exam?

If you do not pass the CLEP exam, you may repeat the exam after a six-month waiting period.

### How do I prepare for a CLEP exam?

Exam descriptions, study guides, and other information are available on The College Board website, [www.collegeboard.com/clep](http://www.collegeboard.com/clep). Study materials are available at major bookstores.

### What do I need to bring to the exam?

You must present a current driver's license or state identification card to be admitted to the test. School ID's are not acceptable identification for this testing program. Lockers are provided to secure your personal items during the exam.
