Cultural Activities

On Campus

TRIO participants are encouraged to attend on-campus speakers, film series, plays, recitals, etc...

TRIO will provide, on a first-come-first-to-go basis, a limited number of tickets to events requiring admission.

- When required, tickets may be obtained from one of the TRIO SSS staff
- Attendance for each event will result in an award of 10 TRIO points per event
- Adherence to the TRiO SSS Attitudes, Behaviors, and Language is expected

Off Campus

In addition to on-campus cultural events and workshops, TRIO SSS provides:

- An evening of theatre at the Masquerade Theatre in Union City
- One overnight trip providing a variety of educational and cultural experiences
 - ✓ Participation limited to Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors who are in good academic standing
 - ✓ Participant number is limited to 24 students
- Reservations may be made with one of the TRIO SSS staff
- Selection will be on a “first-come-first-to-go” basis
- Participants will be asked to provide emergency contact information
- Attendance will result in an award of 10 TRIO points
- Adherence to the TRiO SSS Attitudes, Behaviors, and Language is expected

Annual Honors Banquet

- Eligible participants will attend on a “first-come-first-to-go” basis
- Reservations may be made with one of the TRIO SSS staff after mid-term of the Spring Semester
- Special Invitations will be sent to TRIO Students earning awards
