

GMAT Testing Information

GMAT exam is a computer-adaptive test, which means that questions are selected as you take the exam. A correct answer typically will generate a question of increased difficulty. An incorrect response will generate a question of lesser difficulty. As a result, you will get few questions that are either too easy or too difficult for you. Therefore, you must answer each question presented and you cannot go back and change your previous answers.

COST - \$250 **REGISTER** at www.mba.com

RETESTING - You may retest once every 31 days and no more than 5 times in a 12 month period.

RESCHEDULING - Visit www.mba.com to schedule at least 7 calendar days before the original appointment date and time. A service fee will be charged.

CANCELLING- Visit www.mba.com to cancel at least 7 days before the original appointment date and time to receive a partial refund of your test fee.

GMAT SCORING

UNOFFICIAL SCORE REPORTS may be viewed and printed following your exam. This includes your Quantitative, Verbal, and Total scores.

An **OFFICIAL SCORE REPORT** that includes your Analytical Writing Assessment score will be made available to you online within 20 days after the test. To access your Official Score Report, you will need the Authentication Code that was provided to you with your Unofficial Score Report.

Total Scores range from 200 to 800, with about two-thirds falling between 400 and 600. Verbal and Quantitative Scores range from 0 to 60.
