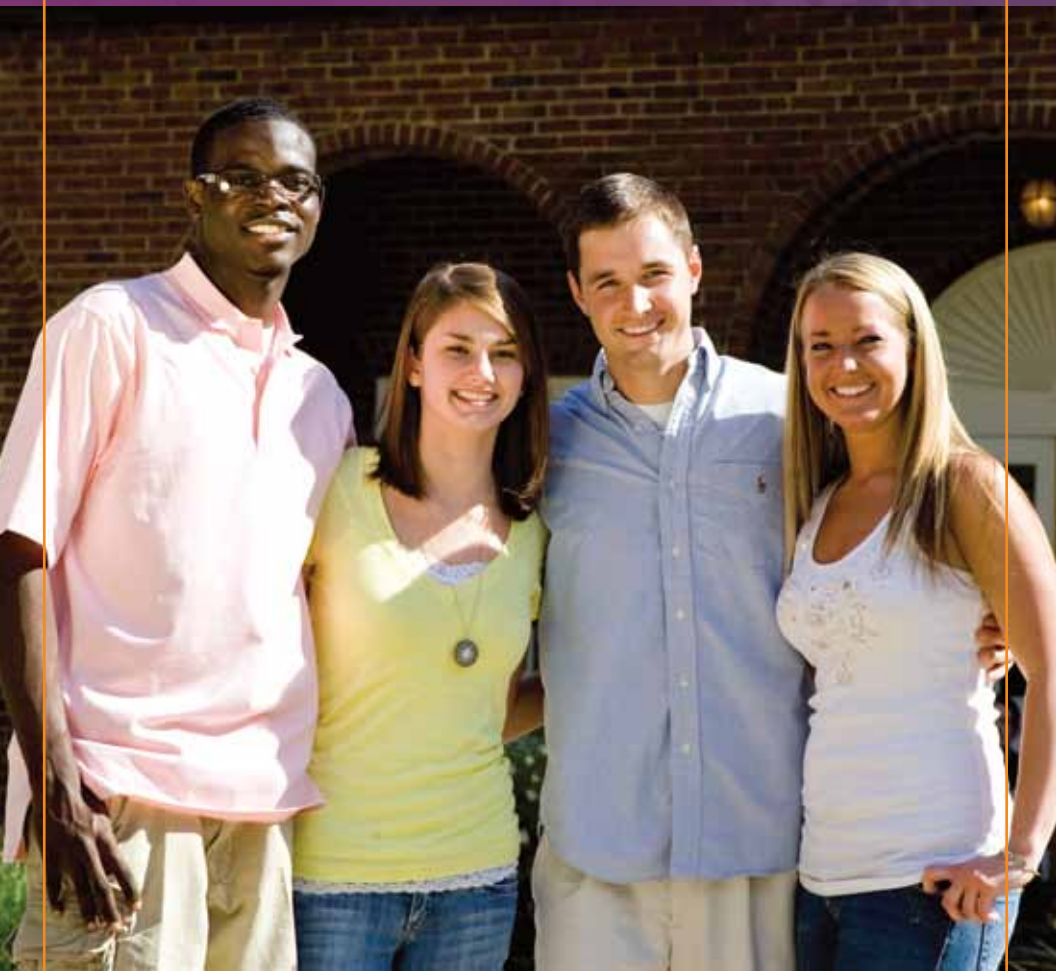

The University: UT Martin is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Ga., 30033-4079, telephone 404-679-4500) to award bachelor's and master's degrees.

Location: Northwest Tennessee about 125 miles northeast of Memphis, 150 miles northwest of Nashville and 60 miles north of Jackson.

Enrollment: Almost 7,600 students from 37 states, 24 foreign countries and 82 of the 95 Tennessee counties.

Student Organizations: More than 100 recognized student organizations and an active Greek system composed of 20 national fraternities and sororities.

Intercollegiate Athletics: The university competes in NCAA Division I in both men's and women's athletics and is a member of the Ohio Valley Conference. The UT Martin rodeo team, the only collegiate rodeo team in Tennessee, is a member of the National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association.

What Will It Cost?

The average cost (2009-10) for a Tennessee resident is \$12,000 per year, which includes tuition, housing, food and books. An out-of-state student should add \$11,400 to this figure. UT Martin offers a variety of scholarships based on academics, leadership and special talents. Approximately 83% of UT Martin students receive some form of financial assistance, and UT Martin awarded more than \$18.1 million in scholarships for 2008-09.
