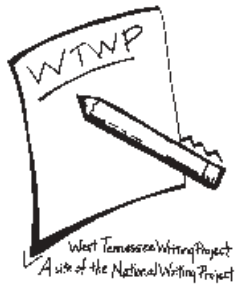


WE WELCOME BONNIE SUNSTEIN
