Clubhouse schedule:

- 9:00 Meet with your group and begin your morning writing activity
- 10:30 Break
- 10:50 Back with your group for more cool activities
- 11:45 Lunch
- 12:45 Creative writing with your group
- 1:45 Break
- 2:00 Read Aloud
- 3:00 Dismiss

- Teachers will meet children in the lobby of Gooch Hall.
- Young writers will be grouped by grade: 3rd and 4th together, 5th and 6th together and 7th and 8th graders together. Each age group will have its own room.
- During the morning session children will be with others their age and will be involved in a fun writing activity led by a Teacher Consultant of the West Tennessee Writing Project. Activities include: writing to music, writing about space, art, poetry, writing plays, and so much more.
- Creative writing continues in the afternoon. Children will have the opportunity to write about whatever topics they choose.
- Read Aloud will be time for children to share some of the writing they have been working on during the day.

What else will be going on? Writing workshops, mini-lessons on content and editing strategies, writing response groups, and one-to-one conferences with West Tennessee Writing Project Teachers.
