UTM Chancellor Keith Carver addressed Kiwanis last week and indicated that he was looking forward to flipping pancakes next year!

In the meantime, Keith reported that he had been actively engaged in visiting 10 cities and 23 high schools in the region, meeting with city managers, high school teachers and 900 students in small sessions of 2 to 10 at a time. He noted that applications for first time students and transfers were up significantly. Tennessee Promise has had a negative impact on enrollments for first and second year students at UTM, but he is very hopeful that UTM can successfully attract students as they enter the last 2 years of their college programs.

Other exciting developments include the funding of the STEM center, plans for the “garage” facility, renovation of EPS and the opening of the Career Planning and Development Center just down the hall from where Kiwanis meets.
