tion on the three mobile food pantries they hold annually. Approximately 250 households receive food for 2 weeks with each distribution. The mobile food pantry is a free grocery distribution for families and individuals that need a little extra help with groceries. A variety of items is available and 25 shopping carts (donated by Walmart) are available to use as people go through the food court. Youth from the church, including several who are Key Leaders, help load groceries in vehicles and deliver to homes. Food is distributed until the truck is empty — usually the distribution takes about one hour. The goal is to feed as many people as possible with the food they are given to distribute. The need is tremendous: 1 in 6 people in Tennessee struggle with hunger and the problem is growing. Anita Hayslett explained that this Mobile Pantry is "an awesome ministry" that has been done for 13 years. Pastor Cowley commented, "We could not do this without the help of other churches, especially Oak Grove and First United Methodist Church." Kiwanian Harry Henderson has helped with many distributions.
