Governor’s Challenge Update: 14 members responded positively to Governor Fred Pitts’ challenge to contribute \$20.17 to Project Eliminate in 2017. A couple of these did this in addition to their regular contribution of \$5.00 monthly they began several years back. If you would like to contribute to the Governor’s challenge, contact Steve, and he can add it to your dues. The goal is “June 2017.” A huge “thank you” goes to those who rose to the challenge thus far.

Walk Across Tennessee: Team K(iwanis) consisted of Maddy, Sara, Otha, Bill, Anna, Linda, Ann and Jim. We racked up the equivalent of 1,363 miles during the 8-week period, which placed us about 16th among the 63 teams. The team with the most miles had 4,118 miles. We were 80 miles behind the team in 15th place.

On a more personal note: if you are not taking part in Governor Fred’s challenge, let me give you another incentive to contribute in a different manner. Last year in honor of our team’s effort in the WAT, I donated 10 cents per team mile to Project Eliminate. If you donate 1¢ (\$13.63), 1/2 ¢ (\$6.82) or even 1/4 ¢ (\$3.41) per team mile, I will match your donation. If 20 “new” people donate even \$3.41 each, 100% of our club will have donated for the year — that alone is an achievement. All “mileage donations” will be matched up to a limit of \$136.30 or 10 cents per mile. If you want to participate, let Steve know. He can hold me to my word on this.
