Phillip gave us detailed information about how the department works to keep the community safe. In a far-ranging discussion, Phillip spoke of the number of department members who had attended the FBI National Academy, the startup costs for new officers, criminal investigations (stolen lawn mower division), how officers work 12 hour shifts with 3-day weekends every second week, the dispatchers’ handling of 20,000 calls a year, and the one officer we like to see “across the street” — codes enforcement.

Although Martin does not have many problems that other municipalities have, it was disappointing to learn that child sex abuse cases are a significant problem.
