She urged everyone to be aware of the "count it - lock it - drop it" efforts being advanced through WCPC and, if possible, to take part in the National RX Take Back Day on October 28 when drug drop off locations and for unwanted drugs will be set up from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at Tennova Healthcare in Martin, Fred's Pharmacy in Dresden, and the Sharon Fire Department.
