Some statistics: 85% high school graduates, 21% bachelor's degree, median household income

\$38,000, county teen pregnancy rate 2.4/1000 vs. state rate 5.4/1000, county health ranking 20, health factors 27, leading causes of death: cancer heart disease, lower respiratory diseases, Alzheimer's and diabetes. Leading behavioral risk factors: physical inactivity, obesity, access to exercise opportunities, alcohol-related accidents and smoking.

Services: family planning, immunizations, maternal and child health, child health/TennCare Kids, STD control, health education, tuberculosis
