Coming to America! Goetz Seifert who was born in Germany during the National Socialist times spoke of his father, who was instrumental in developing several cameras, including photo finish cameras used in the 1936 Olympics, being recruited by American camera companies after the war. Arriving in Miami Beach, Florida with his two brothers, Goetz said that he “had never seen anything like it.” Goetz joined the USAF in the 1950s and was stationed in Morocco and later in Freising, Germany. Eventually becoming a naturalized American citizen, he earned a Ph.D. and came to Martin to teach at UTM. After all, how bad could it be if the county seat was named after the city in which he once resided in Germany. Stressing that he is a proud immigrant and part of the fabric of America, he noted that one of his brothers was involved with NASA and his son Dierk is a major in the USAF. Dierk has made a career in the Air Force and swore his sister Sabina in as a member of the Tennessee National Guard in 2017. It is in this sense that Goetz entitled his talk, “The Seiferts, an Air Force Family and their journey to the skies.”
