Martin Community Band—"Bringing People Together" was the title of Dr John Oelrich's last week. Dr. Oelrich, assistant professor of music and director of bands at UT Martin, organized the Martin Community Band seven years ago and has seen the size of the band grow from 60 musicians the first year to more 100 this year. He is also pleased that the crowds are increasing and said that the related activities, such as the Posters in the Park project and the food trucks on band nights, have helped increase crowds in downtown Martin to as many as 500 persons. Dr. Oelrich talked about his partnership with the City of Martin, the joy of working with a diversity of musicians, and the community band's contribution to building a sense of community identity, character, and charm.
