UTM Chancellor Keith Carver was our guest last week. He was excited to tell us about the exciting things going on at the university. In particular, he discussed the record \$22 million gift by Bill and Rosann Nunnely for scholarships for students from selected rural counties to attend UTM. The first four of these students will begin in fall of 2019.

Enrollment figures for Fall 2019 continue to look very strong, continuing the reversal of those of Fall 2017. Transfers students are most numerous from Jackson State, Dyersburg State and (somewhat surprisingly) Columbia State.

Construction of the Latimer Engineering and Science Building is to begin soon. Its brick and glass façade will complement the Paul Meek Library at the west end. The two will anchor the east and west ends of the quad respectively.
