Yes, Virginia, there will be a rodeo! UT Martin Rodeo Coach John Luthi told the Kiwanis group at a Zoom meeting on Feb. 17 that the 53rd Annual UT Martin Spring College Rodeo would be held on April 15 - 17 but that the venue, the Ned McWherter Agricultural Pavilion, would be at one third capacity because of Covid restrictions. Coach Luthi, who is in his 24th year of coaching the Skyhawks and in his 40th year of coaching, explained that the rodeo would be different from rodeos in the past because of social

distancing and mask requirements but that much excitement and entertainment would still be a part of this event. Coach Luthi explained that the 47-member team features 22 women and 25 men. He thanked Kiwanis members for continuing to support UT Martin athletics and the rodeo. Fifteen Kiwanis members were present for the Zoom meeting where Kiwanian Earl Wright introduced Coach Luthi after Kiwanis President Annie C. Jones welcomed the group. —Photograph by Danelle
