When Dr. Wes Totten, professor and chair of the UT Martin Department of Agriculture, Geosciences, and Natural Resources, gave a recent presentation for Kiwanis, he explained that his department

offers B.S. degrees in five majors: agricultural business, agriculture, geosciences, natural resources management, and veterinary science and technology. He said that those in his department are dedicated to introducing students to the full array of disciplines within each program and that courses are offered that provide experiential training and numerous hands-on, practical learning opportunities through the 640-acre teaching and demonstration farm. Dr. Totten noted that more than 1,000 students are currently enrolled in this department
