

MARTIN, Tenn., Nov. 20, 1991 — UTM EMPLOYEE RECOGNIZED FOR COST-SAVING IDEA— Lee Bennett (center), electronic technician in the computer center at the University of Tennessee at Martin, was recently honored for his idea of repairing computer terminal controller cards, which resulted in UTM saving nearly \$5,000 in 1990. Bennett came up with a way to test controller cards without having to ship them back to the manufacturer. Last year, five cards were repaired at a total cost of \$10.29, resulting in \$4,964.71 in savings since the manufacturer charges \$995 each to repair such cards.
