

2026-2027 UTM DUAL ENROLLMENT APPLICATION & REGISTRATION

All students applying to the Dual Enrollment Program should have an electronic device, social security number, student email (personal email), parent email, parent phone number, and know which course they would like to enroll in for the semester.

Step 1: Go to utm.dualenroll.com to begin the application

Step 2: Login to your Dual Enroll Account

First-time applicants must create an account. Returning users login with their Dual Enroll username and password (not the UTM Portal credentials).

Step 3: Complete the UTM Dual Enrollment Application

Returning students skip ahead to step 5 to complete your course registration.

Step 4: Complete Parent Information

Once the parent's information is entered into the application, they will receive a digital copy of the consent form (text or email) for them to sign. Your application will not process until this step is complete.

Step 5: Finalize Course Registration

Locate the course(s) you wish to take and select "Register" for each course. If you do not see the course(s) you are interested in, please contact the Dual Enrollment Office at 731-881-7853.

Step 6: Review the Application Status

Click on "Status" at the top of the page to ensure your application and course(s) are listed. Courses must be listed for the application to process.

2026-2027 TN DUAL ENROLLMENT GRANT APPLICATION

All students interested in using the Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant to assist with tuition payment must submit a Tennessee Dual Enrollment Grant Application. First time applicants must have a cumulative 3.0 unweighted high school GPA and returning applicants must have a cumulative 2.0 college GPA to remain eligible.

Step 1: Go to collegefortn.org and click on the TSAC Student Portal button (the red button in the top right corner)

Step 2: Login to the TSAC Student Portal

First-time applicants must create an account. Returning users can login with their username and password previously used.

Step 3: Complete the Grant Application

- Click the “Apply” tab on the left-hand side
- Select “Dual Enrollment Grant for Fall 2026, Spring 2027, Summer 2027”
- Complete all required fields and fulfill the acknowledgement checkboxes
 - For the “Primary College/University” field, select “University of TN, Martin, 003531-00.”

Step 4: Review the Financial Summary
