UT Martin is committed to assisting smokers on their journey if they choose to quit completely, as well as cease use while on campus.

Research indicates that it can take multiple attempts to quit and therefore, the University must support these attempts, including cessation programs, support groups, and nicotine replacement therapy.

Students who wish to stop smoking are encouraged to contact Student Health and Counseling Services for information about smoking cessation programs.

Faculty and Staff who wish to stop smoking are encouraged to contact Human Resources.
