MANDATORY HEALTH INSURANCE

OTHER COSTS

Scenarios – Some examples to help you calculate

Mohi is a new degree student from India. She came in with a TOEFL 69, so she will go directly to degree classes. She has been advised and is registered for 17 credits. She wants a private room, so she is going to live in University Village Phase 2. She would like a full meal plan. She needs one year of insurance. These are her costs PER SEMESTER

One semester of tuition	\$11,846.00
University Village Phase 2	\$3,210.00
Full meal plan	\$1,738.00
Basic Insurance one semester	\$200.00
Books (rental and used)	\$600.00
Spending and some travel	\$2,000.00
TOTAL FOR ONE SEMESTER	\$19,594.00

BANK STATEMENT SUBMISSION – Homeland Security Regulations

In order to be admitted, you must submit a financial statement with the following amounts for tuition and living:

TIEP-to-degree or full degree- student only: \$33, 270.00 TIEP Only student only: \$20, 794 (\$5,198.50 per term)

TIEP-to-degree or full degree with family: \$43,270.00 TIEP Only with family: \$30,764 (\$7,691 per term)
