Mission Statement: Our mission is to provide a safe, supportive, and diverse environment that enables all students to formulate their academic, technical, and vocational skills as they develop their roles as responsible citizens.

Underserved Statement: Henry County students do not always get the opportunities to see the different arts because once students leave the school, they no longer have a way to view performances. Through the efforts of the music, theater, and arts programs within the county, more students have the opportunity to be exposed to things they have not seen before. Krider Performing Arts Center (KPAC) also aims to give students in the area to participate in their performances. Henry County Schools are hoping to provide students with more in school activities that will bring the arts to them.

Arts Advocacy Statement: The Henry County School System views the arts as an integral part to the success of each student. In the past, music programs have been invited to perform for school board meetings, local parades, and much more. At each event, an administrator and local county officials have been present. Each music director in Henry County are members of the National Association for Music Education, the West Tennessee Band and Orchestra Association, the West Tennessee Vocal Music Educator's Association, and the Tennessee Music Educator's Association. Each of these organizations fight for opportunities for Henry County School System students to perform and earn scholarship opportunities. The local newspaper, The Paris Intelligencer, is present at all music events and consistently writes articles that promote attendance to such events as well as high praise for the program. The county also offers a Treble Honor Choir for all elementary school students. This event brings music to all students that can attend. At this event, students from different schools within the county come together to learn from county music teachers and perform a concert to conclude the daylong event. There is also a chance for students at the middle school level to perform with a county wide jazz program. These students perform at local concerts along with the high school jazz band. The choral programs within the county are constantly bringing music to those who do not have access. The top choral program performs for each elementary/ middle school, local businesses, and at statewide events. The high school band program offers many different opportunities to bring music into the community. The school board recently voted and approved plans to build a separate building to hold the growing high school band program. County officials saw a need to expand the current band room for the program to continue its growth. The Krider Performing Arts Center (KPAC) in Henry County holds many arts events that enrich the community. They hold plays, musicals, and concerts. We as a school system are always looking for ways to support this wonderful organization and its efforts to bring arts to those who may not have access like the students in the school system. The Henry County School System wants the best for the students all around and they truly believe arts education is a part of that.
