5. ... *Proficiency core skill areas in general education will be assessed using a standardized test approved by the Tennessee Higher Education Commission.*

The POST COMP test is a required test for graduation. It is an important assessment that faculty should advise students to take seriously.

In 2015, the SSC testing center proctored 1026 POST COMP assessments.

Yes, believe it or not, students walk in to the testing center and tell us that their advisor told them that this was unimportant and “just go take it”.

We have had students complete the assessment in just minutes!

It is recommended that students be advised to sign up for and take the POST COMP assessment once they have 100 hours completed. The data on this assessment is reported to THEC and is a part (albeit small) of our State funding.

There is no charge for this exam, so advise your students to take this assessment as soon as they are eligible. Have your student go to <http://www.registerblast.com/utm/exam> to sign up. The student will also receive several email reminders and a hold when the time is right.

Accessibility Team
