

Level 5	Level 5, Most Effective: Significant evidence that the teacher's students made more growth than expected (the teacher's index is 2 or greater).
Level 4	Level 4, Above Average Effectiveness: Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made more growth than expected (the teacher's index is between 1 and 2).
Level 3	Level 3, Average Effectiveness: Evidence that the teacher's students made growth as expected (the teacher's index is between -1 and 1).
Level 2	Level 2, Approaching Average Effectiveness: Moderate evidence that the teacher's students made less growth than expected (the teacher's index is between -2 and -1).
Level 1	Level 1, Least Effective: Significant evidence that the teacher's students made less growth than expected (the teacher's index is less than -2).

When an index falls exactly on the boundary between colors, the higher effectiveness level is assigned. Teachers who teach multiple subjects/grades are counted separately for each subject/grade in this report.
