

# UTM Educator Preparation Program 2021-2025 Completer Data

## Undergraduate and Graduate Initial Licensure: Admission Data based on Completers

UTM experienced an decrease in the number of completers from 2022-2023 to 2023-2024. The GPA before Student Teaching decreased by 0.04 points this year. Final GPA also slightly decreased (-0.04).

Of those who were full admits (being admitted by using the ACT and not the Praxis CORE tests), the average ACT composite was a 23.38. UTM saw a slight increase in appeals from 2022-2023 (1) to 2023-2024 (3), and within those completers who were admitted by appeal, their GPAs at admission to the program decreased slightly (-0.21), had a higher ACT composite score of 20.33 (+1.33), slightly decreased GPA before Student Teaching (-0.22), and a slightly lower Final GPA -0.26) than the previous year’s appeal students. Despite these lower comparisons to the previous year, the four year trends in all areas are still trending highly and showing marked improvements over 2020-21 and 2021-22.

Completer data also provides UTM predictive analysis for what is to come on Domain 1 TDOE Annual Reports and TN Report Card Candidate Profile.

All students seeking admission to the University of Tennessee at Martin’s Educator Preparation Programs are required to submit the results of a criminal background check. The Educator Preparation Program staff monitor criminal background checks daily in the online Tennessee Bureau of Investigation TN FlexCheck System. The results are reviewed and entered into Banner SOATEST daily. When a background check has an incident cited, the Director of the Educator Preparation Program schedules an in-person meeting with the student to review the results and counsel the student on how to proceed. The students are advised of the expungement process if it is an incident which can be removed from their record. Anyone with a felony citation or a citation involving children is denied continuation in the education major.

The above chart shows the number of background checks received for each semester. The chart is updated at the end of each semester.

The citations noted on the criminal background checks that required counseling or denial include:

1. Driving under the influence
2. Theft- occurred 10 years ago or longer
