This year, students may choose to attend a half-day or full-day.

Full-day Schedule:

8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.

Lunch will be at 11:00 a.m. for all campers. Please send lunch daily.

**Half-day Schedule:** 

8:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m. <u>OR</u> 12:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m.

Students attending half days will not eat lunch at Kid College.

## What is Kid College?

Kid College is a 5-day program for children who will attend 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade in fall of 2024. Our goal for Kid College is to provide your child an opportunity to have a fun, learning experience. We have many interesting and exciting courses. You and your child may review the course descriptions and select the course(s) they wish to take based on their interests and the appropriate grade level.

## **Prior to Kid College**

- Register your child online in advance.
- Registration fees:
  - Junior Kid College-\$175
  - Kid College-\$250 for full-day OR \$150 for half-day
- Payment is due at the time of registration.
- T-shirt is included with registration fees.
- Emails with your child's schedule and other important information will be sent on the Wednesday before Kid College.

#### **First Day**

- Arrive 15-20 minutes prior to your child's first class to pick up his/her nametag and t-shirt.
- After the first day, arrive 10 minutes before the first class.

## **Supply Fees**

Supply fees have been eliminated!

# Clothing

Students are encouraged to wear play clothes and tennis shoes. Some classes will be held outside in the quad area.

Please make sure your child wears their provided name tag DAILY.

Nametags include important scheduling information needed for each individual student.

#### **Backpack**

Provide a backpack for supplies and be sure to label your belongings!

Children will be supervised at all times, including lunch. They will be escorted to and from each class at each period and class rosters are checked hourly.

#### Lunch

If your child will have lunch at Kid College, please provide lunch and a drink daily. The food cart is no longer available. No child will be allowed to leave for lunch without an escort.

- K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade students attending Junior Kid College will not have lunch. Please provide a snack daily.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade students will all eat lunch at 11:00 a.m. Please send lunch daily.
