## WestTeach Purpose

WestTeach is the premier leadership development program for teachers in the 21 counties of West Tennessee. The program topics will expose our teachers to relevant and influential issues that can shape and reshape the classroom engagement for their students. Teachers will be challenged and equipped to translate their WestTeach experiences into transformational opportunities for their students.

#### WestTeach Mission

The WestTeach mission is to engage and equip West Tennessee teachers with tools and leadership skills for success in and outside the classroom.

WestStar Mission: WestStar Leadership educates, engages, and empowers a diverse group of community-minded individuals to collaborate, lead, and serve to facilitate positive change in West Tennessee.

#### Selection Criteria

Applicants must be K-12 teachers who aspire to stay in the classroom and want to be leaders in their schools and communities. They should be nominated by their Director/Superintendent of Schools. Selection is also based on leadership achievements and potential to contribute to the region's educational system.

#### **Application Process**

Applicants must submit their application with a letter of recommendation from their Principal. Applications are reviewed and selected by the WestTeach Leadership Advisory Council. One teacher per school district will be selected with a maximum of 30 members per class. It is a requirement that each class member attend all sessions, the opening session, and graduation. If requirement can't be met, then applicant needs to wait until next year. Applications can be found online at utm.edu/westteach.

#### Cost

Tuition for WestTeach is \$250. Tuition must be paid by the participant or their school system prior to the first session. Upon graduation, each teacher will be given a \$100 gift card to be used for their classroom.
