CONFERENCE TRACKS

Proposals must be structured around experiential education areas of interest relevant to any level(s) of education. Additionally, the proposal should fit within **one or more** of the following conference tracks, although additional tracks will be considered:

- Assessment, Evaluation, & Student Research
- Entrepreneurship
- Career Development
- Challenges of Experiential Learning
- Agriculture
- Addressing Diversity
- Healthcare
- Experiential Learning F2F or Online
- Service Learning, Internships, & Cooperative Education
- K – 12 Education
- Post-secondary Education
- Travel/Study Abroad

SESSION TYPES

Proposals must be structured around one of the following conference session types:

- Traditional Presentation (30 minutes, **April 3**)
- Workshop (90 minutes, April 3)
- Small-group Round Table Discussion (60 – 90 minutes for total activity: 8 minutes/presenter, April 3)
- Poster Presentations (from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m., **April 4**)

SUBMISSION & NOTIFICATION

Proposals/abstracts must be no longer than **250 words in length, double-spaced**; no citations required. All proposals are double-blind, peer reviewed. *Incomplete proposals or improperly formatted proposals will not be considered.* Applicants will be notified of the status of their proposals by **March 12, 2024**. Applicants will need to register for the conference by **March 15, 2024**.
