- Post-secondary Education (all disciplines)
- Travel/Study Abroad

### SESSION TYPES

Proposals must be structured around one of the following conference session types:

- Traditional Presentation (30 minutes, **April 3**)
- Poster Presentations (from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., **April 3**)

### SUBMISSION & NOTIFICATION

Proposals/abstracts must be no longer than **250 words in length, double-spaced**; no citations required. All proposals are double-blind, peer reviewed. *Incomplete proposals or improperly formatted proposals will not be considered.* Applicants will be notified of the status of their proposals by **March 12, 2025**. Applicants will need to register for the conference by **March 15, 2025**.
